2015 Jack Cavill Pole Position Cup - STANDINGS

There is a £3,400 prize fund for The Jack Cavill Pole Position Cup (£150 and a trophy for the pole position winner for races one and three each weekend, a trophy for the pole position starter for race two, plus £1,000 for the driver with the most poles).

The award is named after Jack Cavill, who played a vital supporting role in the early careers of several notable drivers from the 1960s onwards.

The prizes are presented at each round by Jack's son John, who has followed in his father's footsteps, helping famous names such as Tim Sugden, Will Power and Anthony Wilds (son of Mike). The 2013 Jack Cavill Pole Position Cup was won by champion Jake Hughes with George Russell claiming the 2014 prize, having taken the award on a tie-break ahead of his Lanar Racing team-mate Arjun Maini.
